## Adventist Health and Rideout Electrophysiology Program Surpasses 500th Heart Ablation Procedure

Adventist Health and Rideout is proud to announce that its electrophysiology program, led by Dr. R.P. Singh, has successfully completed over 500 heart ablations, addressing more than 600 heart arrhythmias in the process. Notably, the program's complication rate stands at a remarkable 0.4%, significantly below the national average of 4.5% for ablation procedures.

Currently, the program's catheterization (cath) laboratory is the only facility in the greater Sacramento region offering completely fluoroscopy-free procedures and is one of the few accredited by the American College of Cardiology (ACC) in the state.
